

Know your Days Learn about Watering Restrictions

Water is a resource shared by all, and as Florida's population increases, so does the need for all of Florida's residents to conserve. Water conservation may seem unnecessary in a state surrounded by water, but not all of that water is readily available for drinking or irrigation. The City of Minneola is doing its part to conserve water through Landscape Irrigation Schedules. These schedules were passed as a City Ordinance on April 21, 2009 and support the St. John's River Water Management District watering restrictions.

Landscape Irrigation Schedules:

Residential Properties (Even Numbered Homes)

Daylight Savings Time:
Thursday and Sunday only- no irrigation between I0am and 4pm Standard Eastern Time:
Sunday only- no irrigation between I0am and 4pm

Residential Properties (Odd Numbered Homes)

Daylight Savings Time:
Wednesday and Saturday only- no irrigation between I0am and 4pm Standard Eastern Time:
Saturday only- no watering between I0am and 4pm

Non-Residential Properties

<u>Daylight Savings Time</u>: Tuesday and Friday only- no irrigation between I0am and 4pm <u>Standard Eastern Time</u>: Tuesday only- no irrigation between I0am and 4pm

Note: Daylight Savings time occurs from the second Sunday in March through the first Sunday in November. Standard Eastern Time occurs from the first Sunday in November through the second Sunday in March.

Irrigation of New Landscape:

Prior to installing new landscape, stop by the Planning Department at Minneola City Hall to complete a no cost Notice of Intent. This provides you and the City of Minneola important information to ensure that your new landscape receives the appropriate amount of watering without penalty.

Irrigation of new landscape is allowed at any time of day on any day for the initial 30 days and every other day for the next 30 days for a total of one 60-day period, provided that the irrigation is limited to the minimum amount necessary for establishment.
